## Peace 2: Finding It

**The Big Idea:** Job is pursuing peace by pursuing the truth about who God is. He is asking the questions, how could you let this happen to me? We can, and should present our lack of peace before God, but then we need to let him answer, and we need to listen. God restores our sight, to remember who he is, why we worship him, and why that brings us peace.

## Discussion

### **Job 5:8-19**

1. Job has lost nearly everything and lost his peace. How would you go about finding peace in such a situation?
2. What does Job's friend Eliphaz suggest Job should do after losing everything?
3. Summarize what Eliphaz is saying in verses 17-19. Have you ever been told something like that? Have you ever told someone else that? How'd it go?
4. Have you ever been 'corrected' by God? How so?

### **Job 38-42 God responds to the questions of his own creation.**

5. God responds to Job in chapters 38-41. How does his response make you feel? Put yourself in Job's place; how would you respond?
6. In Job 42:1-6, how does Job respond?
7. What does God's response and Job's response tell us about Finding Peace?
8. How can we keep finding peace as circumstances change, people change, you change, etc.?
9. Seeing how Job found peace, what did Jesus mean that he gives the gift of peace - peace of mind and heart in John 14:27?
