Financial Highlights for October 2023

Our operating income for the month of October totaled \$23,770. October operating expenses totaled \$16,606 for a net gain of \$\$7,164 for the month.

Year to date through the end of October, the church has received a total of \$171,059 in contributions and other income to support the operations of the church. Total operating expenses through October were \$159,117 for a year-to-date net gain of \$11,942.

Combining this \$11,942 net gain with the year-beginning operating reserves of \$39,956 gives the church a total liquidity of \$51,898.

The mortgage balance for the roof replacement and solar panels project loan is \$62,067.

The 2023 and 2024 budgets are being reassessed to include the financial impact of Rev. Holmes' resignation.

Water leaks indicate the need for roof repair / replacement. The potential budget impacts Rare being assessed.

The draft 2024 budget is being prepared for Session consideration at the December meeting.
