

Good morning!

At the end of May, the Dignity Mission organized a productive trip to the border. The Bowlins and the Ferrells drove down three vehicles on May 29th, transporting a significant amount of supplies, including thousands of Dignity Kit towels, 1,960 granola bars, 570 pounds of beans and rice, 12 pounds of pasta, 130 T-shirts, a box of jackets, and eight pairs of men's underwear.

On the following morning, 19 volunteers gathered at Dr. Moya's garage and driveway in El Paso to assemble 2,030 Dignity Kits. Thanks to continued donations, all toiletry items for these kits were purchased and shipped directly to Dr. Moya. The assembled kits will be distributed within the next two weeks to shelters and displaced individuals on both sides of the border. Attached are photos of both the assembly volunteers and the recipients in Ciudad Juárez from last month's distribution. The next kit assembly event is scheduled for August 22nd in El Paso.

The number of people released from detention in the United States and deported daily to Juárez changes regularly. Last month, these totals were lower than those recorded in March. Nevertheless, many deportees remain in Juárez, seeking shelter and employment, or trying to obtain the documentation necessary to relocate. The situation continues to be dynamic, and humanitarian needs persist.

During the mission, connections with several local organizations were established, enabling coordinated distribution and ensuring that the kits reached those most in need. Feedback from recipients and partner groups was overwhelmingly positive, emphasizing the immediate improvement these supplies brought to daily comfort and dignity. Volunteers noted that the sense of community developed during the assembly event was inspiring and reinforced the commitment to ongoing support.
