My friends, today I want to remind you about some exciting events happening in the life of our congregation in the next two weeks.

First, we have two adult forums coming up this Sunday and on April 2 at 9:30am in the Upper Room. This Sunday, Miguel Zulueta will be leading Part Two of an adult forum titled "Powerful Time for Renewal". This forum is about how we can make Lent a time for renewal by releasing habits that no longer serve us or God, and taking a deep dive into the still waters of the Spirit so we can welcome new visions for our lives. The adult forum I will be leading on April 2 is titled "Is My Bible Accurate?" Surely at some time in your life you have noticed that we have different translations of the bible, and sometimes some bibles will even include things that other bibles omit. Why do we have these different translations? Which bible is the right one, if any? Finally, how do we know if any of them accurately retell the stories of the bible as they were meant to be told? I will seek to answer these questions in this class on April 2.

Today, I also want to remind you that we will be having a Passover Seder on Thursday, April 6 at 6pm. The seder is a meal at the time of the Passover holiday to remember the time when God led the Israelite slaves out of their captivity in Egypt on their long journey to the Promised Land. This is the meal that Jesus was sharing with his disciples at the Last Supper, an event which we as Christians remember every time we celebrate communion. So, I hope you will join us for this seder as together we gain at a richer understanding of the Last Supper and the sacrament of communion. This Sunday, the scripture readings will be Psalm 130 and John 11: 1-45. My sermon is titled "Who's in Charge?". Please join me in person at 8:30am or 10:30 am, or over Zoom at 10:30am.
