Most of the activities will be canceled on April 17, due to spring break, however, the Worship Choir will still have rehearsal that night at 7:00 PM. The praise band will be joining us to go through all the songs for Easter Sunday, as well as the Tech Crew checking sound, light, and video projection for the day.

Worship Choir Vision 2019

Last year our choir officers and myself met and shared in discussions about the choir year and set some goals for the year. I've shared some of those goals and strategies to reach them so that this year will be like no other we have experienced. Some of the goals for this year include:

- Increase enrollment and attendance by 20% during 2019 – (71 to 85 enr. **80 currently**) (42 to 50 att. **51 currently**)
- Expand Care Groups to 12, to accommodate larger enrollment—**currently 12**
- Increase fellowship opportunities for choir – two major outings, in addition to monthly parties
- Provide at least two opportunities for the choir to sing/minister, outside regular church service worship leading – service projects; mission trips; concert opportunities
- Continually stress the importance of personal spiritual development and growing relationships – to God, to other Believers, and the non-Believer
- Congregational songs without folders – using words on screen
- Memorization of choir anthems on a monthly basis, to communicate more strongly with the worshipping congregation
