Objective: You will help FUPC to glorify God through active discipleship, faithful

service, and nurturing fellowship by providing comfort and care for infants and toddlers, from newborn to three (3) years of age, while their parents attend Sunday services, Sunday School, and other scheduled Church

activities and commitments.

Result 1: Two Childcare Volunteers (at least one over 21 years of age) arrive at

their assigned time(s) to serve. Youth volunteers must be members of

FUPC.

Result 2: Children and their parents are greeted upon arrival and made to feel

welcome and secure; assistance is provided in completing the formal

check-in process.

Result 3: Comfort is provided for crying children in the Childcare Room and all

children are regularly prayed for while being nurtured.

Result 4: Infants in the Crib Room are fed and diapers of all children are changed

as required.

Result 5: Childcare Volunteers are familiar with all emergency plans and response

protocols for fire, storm, earthquake, and medical emergencies.

Result 6: Assistance is provided to the Sunday Childcare Supervisor (if staff

member is in place) in putting laundry in hampers and cleaning Childcare

Room after conclusion of Church activities/services.

Result 7: Childcare Volunteers understand, acknowledge, and follow all

requirements delegated to them by the Sunday Childcare Supervisor as

outlined within the manual known as the "Responsibilities: Worship

Childcare Supervisor and Childcare Volunteers."

Team Composition (number): six (6) to 20 volunteers.

Time Commitment: One Sunday morning about every eight (8) weeks from 10:00 A.M.-11:45 A.M.

Special Talents and Skills Preferred: An active, committed disciple of Christ; comfortable interacting with toddlers; patience; flexibility.
