MINISTRY DESCRIPTION



Bible Verse: “People were bringing little children to him in order that He might touch them; and the disciples spoke sternly to them. But when Jesus saw this, He was indignant and said to them, ‘Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will never enter it.’ And He took them up in His arms, laid His hands on them, and blessed them.” (Mark 10:13-16)

Objective: *You will help FUPC to glorify God through meaningful worship with children ages 3 through 3rd grade by creating a worship environment that cultivates the imagination and invites children to fall in love with God.*

Result 1: A commitment has been made to lead worship as scheduled.

Result 2: The names and faces of children who regularly attend are known and a commitment to creating a welcoming environment for all children who attend has taken place.

Result 3: The children are prayed for regularly.

Result 4: The Worship Leader has received training so that an improved knowledge of the Bible and a better understanding of the order of worship have been acquired.

Result 5: The Worship Leader has access to the story materials to study and prepare in order to present the story in the way that the curriculum is written.

Result 6: The Worship Leader has received encouragement and support from the coordinators.

Result 7: The children have been greeted by name.

Team Composition (number): Six (6) to eight (8).

Time Commitment: Approximately 5.5 hours per week
Sunday schedule:

- Set up Children's Chapel to greet children as they arrive with their families and to pass out worship bags approximately 30 minutes before the 10:30 A.M. service
- Be in attendance for the length of the Time with Children in the Sanctuary
- Stay for approximately 10 minutes after conclusion of Children's Chapel

Special Talents and Skills Preferred: Public Speaking.

Spiritual Gifts: Discernment, Faith, Hospitality, Knowledge, Leadership, Mercy, Service/Helper, Teaching.

Support and Accountability: Worship Committee, Christian Education Committee, Director of Christian Discipleship, and Children's Chapel Coordinator.

Resources and Training Provided: Chance to observe before making commitment plus initial training and two (2) to three (3) enrichment training courses per year.

Requirement: Active Member of FUPC for at least six (6) months; willingness to undergo a background check.
