K-5 SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER

MINISTRY DESCRIPTION



Objective: *You will help FUPC to glorify God through meaningful worship, active discipleship, faithful service, and nurturing fellowship by providing for the spiritual formation of children by developing relationships with them, modeling an authentic Christian faith, and teaching them the essentials of following Christ.*

Result 1: Sunday School teachers volunteer weekly in the Sunday School class for one month.

Result 2: The children of the FUPC children's ministry are prayed for regularly.

Result 3: The Sunday School teachers know the names and faces of all children who participate in their particular Sunday School class.

Result 4: Sunday School teachers are investing the time weekly that is necessary to thoroughly prepare for assigned tasks.

Result 5: Sunday School teachers are receiving encouragement, support, and training as well time for prayer and troubleshooting as needed with the Director of Christian Discipleship.

Result 6: The Sunday School teachers are informed about any special victories, concerns, or challenges being faced by the children and their families and, as often as reasonable, pass that information on to the Director of Christian Discipleship.

Result 7: Through regular strategizing with the Director of Christian Discipleship, children and/or parents are connecting with the children's ministry programs.

Result 8: The Sunday School schedule is coordinated with the Director of Christian Discipleship, staff, and other teachers.

Result 9: Sunday School teachers are regular participants in the weekly worship service at FUPC.

Result 10: Sunday School teachers are adhering to the Safe Church Policy of FUPC.

Result 11: Sunday School teachers attend training events.

K-5 SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER

MINISTRY DESCRIPTION

Team Composition (number): Two (2)-teacher team per month.

Time Commitment: Seventy-five (75) minutes on Sunday mornings (9:00-10:15 am).

- One (1) hour lesson preparation.
- The following are some possible ways the teacher could build relationships as time allows:
 - Attend CE Ministry events/programs as time allows.
 - Attend student events (games, meets, concerts, ceremonies) as time allows.
 - Celebrate important times in a student's life by sending a card, a text, a voicemail, etc.

Total weekly time commitment: approximately two (2) hours.

Special Talents and Skills Preferred: Passion for children, Organized, Creative, Leadership.

Spiritual Gifts: Artistic Expression, Leadership, Hospitality, Mercy, Service/Helper, Teaching

Support and Accountability: Director of Christian Discipleship and Christian Education Committee.

Resources and Training Provided: Attend volunteer training events and utilize curriculum and other resources provided by the Director of Christian Discipleship.

Requirement: Active member of FUPC for at least six (6) months; at 21 years old; willingness to undergo a background check.
