And how are they to hear without someone to proclaim him? And how are they to proclaim him unless they are sent? As it is written, ‘How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!’ But not all have obeyed the good news; for Isaiah says, ‘Lord, who has believed our message?’ So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes through the word of Christ.” Romans 10:12-17

**Result #6:**     Sunday School teachers are regular participants in the weekly worship service at First United Presbyterian.

**Team Composition (number):**     as needed

**Time Commitment:**     1 hour teaching on Sunday  
  3-5 hours preparation during the week  
  Total Weekly Time Commitment about 6 hours

**Special Talents and Skills Preferred:** Any of the following: Public Speaking, Passion to share the Word of God, Willingness to learn, Ability to facilitate discussion

**Spiritual Gifts:** Any of the following: Discernment, Teaching, Wisdom, Knowledge, Leadership, Shepherding, Exhortation, Faith, Evangelism, Apostleship, Service/Helper, Mercy, Hospitality

**Support and Accountability:** Director of Christian Education and the Christian Education Committee

**Resources and Training Provided:** Changes month to month, depends on the class teaching

**Requirement:** Active member of FUPC, at least 6 months, plus approval by the Christian Education Committee; willingness to undergo a background check
