GREETER – CHILDREN’S CHAPEL (VOLUNTEER)
MINISTRY DESCRIPTION**



“People were bringing little children to him in order that he might touch them; and the disciples spoke sternly to them. But when Jesus saw this, he was indignant and said to them, ‘Let the little children come to me; do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs. Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will never enter it.’ And he took them up in his arms, laid his hands on them, and blessed them.” Mark 10:13-16

Objective: *You will help FUPC to glorify God through meaningful worship with children ages 3 through 3rd grade by creating a worship environment that cultivates the imagination and invites children to fall in love with God.*

Result #1: A commitment has been made to greet the children and assist the Worship Leader in worship as scheduled.

Result #2: The names and faces of children who regularly attend are known and a commitment to creating a welcoming environment for all children who attend has taken place.

Result #3: The children are prayed for regularly.

Result #4: The Greeter has received training so that an improved knowledge of the Bible and a better understanding of the order of worship have been acquired.

Result #5: The Greeter has knowledge on how the worship space is to be set up on Feast Sundays and on Work Sundays.

Result #6: The Greeter has received encouragement and support from the coordinators.

Result #7: The Children have been greeted by name in the hall at First United Presbyterian.

Team Composition (number): 8-10

Time Commitment: On the Sunday scheduled:

- 15 minutes before the 10:30 service for set up,
- the length of the Sanctuary service,
- 10 minutes afterwards

Special Talents and Skills Preferred: Patience

Spiritual Gifts: Any of the following: Discernment, Faith, Helps, Hospitality, Knowledge, Leadership, Mercy, Teaching,

Support and Accountability: Worship Committee, Christian Education Committee, Director of Christian Education and Children’s Chapel Coordinator

Resources and Training Provided: Chance to observe before making commitment; plus initial training and 2-3 enrichment trainings per year

Requirement: Active Member of FUPC, at least 6 months; willingness to undergo a background check
