WE STARTED AN ONGOING PARTNERSHIP WITH DONATE DELAWARE AT THE START OF SUMMER. IN JULY, THE FOOD TRUCK PROVIDED FOOD FOR AN OUTREACH IN CECILTON MARYLAND WITH REAL LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH.

IN AUGUST, THE FOOD TRUCK PROVIDED FREE FOOD TO THE BROOKSIDE COMMUNITY IN RESPONSE TO AN EXTENDED POWER OUTAGE DUE TO STORM DAMAGE. OUR BACKPACK OUTREACHES KICKED OFF IN AUGUST WITH SEVERAL APARTMENT COMPLEXES AND THE FOLLOWING SCHOOLS; ASPIRA, BALTZ, BRADER, BROOKSIDE, HERITAGE, & NEW CASTLE.

IN APRIL WE CONTINUED EASTER BASKET OUTREACHES IN THE COMMUNITY. THE FOOD TRUCK BEGAN IT'S 2023 OUTREACHES. LOCAL NON-PROFITS, CORPORATIONS, SCHOOLS, & OTHER GROUPS CONTINUED TO VOLUNTEER TO PACK BOXES OF HOPE. IN PARTNERSHIP WITH WILMINGTON HOUSING AUTHORITY WE HOSTED THE YOUTH BUILD PROGRAM. ON JUNE THIRD WE HOSTED OUR THIRD ANNUAL HOPE DAY WITH OVER 2,000 IN ATTENDANCE.

THE AUTUMN STARTED WITH A GENEROUS DONATION OF PREPARED MEALS FROM GOLO, ALONG WITH A MONETARY DONATION AND COATS FROM A COAT DRIVE THEY HELD IN CONNECTION WITH US AND ONE WARM COAT. LIVING FREE TRAINING BEGAN AND CONSTRUCTION ON UNIT 12 FOR THE NAAMAN'S CENTER STARTED. OUR THANKSGIVING OUTREACH WAS A SUCCESS WITH 850 TURKEYS & BOXES OF HOPE GIVEN OUT TO THE COMMUNITY.
