Medication:

If your student takes medication, please bring all medication in the labeled, original bottle and place all medication in a Ziplock bag with the student's name on it. Also, include the "permission to give medication" form for each medication. This will be taken up the day we leave and will be kept by a sponsor. If you do not fill the form out, no medication will be given to your child.

What to bring:

- A great attitude
 - Bible, notepad, and pen
 - Small bag for Bible, notepad and pen. (Drawstring, etc)
 - Linens, pillow, blankets, sleeping bag (bedding for single mattress)
 - 2 towels (1 for shower, 1 for swimming)
 - Water bottle you can refill and carry with you (write name on it)
 - Closed-toe, closed-heel shoes (for outdoor activities)
 - Toiletries such as toothbrush, soap, shampoo, etc.
 - Deodorant (not optional)
 - Sun screen, insect repellent
 - Spending money for snacks in vending machines (Small bills are suggested since there is not a change machine)
 - Summer clothing, we will be outside most of the day (see dress code)
 - PJ's
 - Trash bag for dirty clothes (or any bag)
 - Clothes for messy/wet games
 - Clothes for worship. It does not have to be dressy; shorts and t-shirts are great; they just will want to be able to put clean clothes on after being outside all day.
 - Shower shoes (optional, but never a bad idea)
 - Swimsuit and a dark shirt to wear while swimming as well as shoes to wear to and from swimming areas
 - A watch (optional, but a good idea so they will know what time it is)
 - A light jacket or sweater (they may get cold inside after being outside all day, it happens)
 - Snacks, but it must be in a resealable bag (no nuts due to peanut allergies)
 - We will be in cabins where space is limited, we realize you are packing for a week however, don't pack crazy because you won't have anywhere to put your stuff
 - Lake/swim shoes (for the blob, canoes or lake swimming), if desired
- ❖ For our younger campers/first time campers it may be a good idea to pack daily clothes in labeled Ziplock bags. This helps them to know what to wear and helps avoid the Thursday conversation of "I don't have any more clean clothes."

What not to bring:

- No cell phones or electronic devices (if you can plug it in, don't bring it). Medical devices are allowed
- Alcohol, tobacco, e-cigarettes, illegal drugs, fireworks, water guns, or any kind of weapon
- No roller blades or skateboards.
- Items that may be used for pranks such as water balloons, shaving cream, silly string, etc. Pranks are not allowed at camp.

Students are NOT to pack anything that:

- Advertises alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs;
- Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person;
- Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations;
- Has spaghetti/small straps or open back, except for sleepwear;
- Is excessively short or tight fitting.

Dress code:

- All students and sponsors are to dress in a way that represents Jesus Christ in an appropriate manner.
- Wear modest shorts (no “short shorts” or “soffe” shorts allowed) Short-shorts are those higher than when your hands are down at your side.
- Wear closed-toe and closed-heel shoes while outside at activities.
- Wear modest swim suit. Everyone is required to wear a dark colored t-shirt to, in and from the swimming areas.
- All shirts must have sleeves, no tank tops or spaghetti strap tops.
- Do not dress in a way that calls attention to underwear (sagging your pants, rolling up your waistbands, etc.) or wear pants or shorts with lettering across the bottom.

Special Dietary/Physical Restrictions:

If your child has a dietary need/restriction or a physical need/restriction please contact Brian Barton before camp. This will allow us to communicate and work with the camp to make sure we have everything needed for the week of camp.
