Job Description and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the overall Guest First Impressions at BCCC
- Recruit and train Guest Service volunteers
- Follow-up with BCCC visitors
- Conduct regular BCCC 101 (and other classes as determined beneficial)
- Conduct regular "Get Acquainted" receptions for visitors (quarterly)
- Identify gifts/talents and areas of potential service for BCCC members as an opportunity to bless the church/community and grow the believer
- Obtain needs for volunteers from other ministry leaders and provide them with names of persons who could potentially fulfill those needs
- Provide pastoral care for BCCC members as needed

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS Continued:

- Serve as staff Men's Ministry representative
- Preach on Sunday mornings as needed (maximum 4-6 times per year)
- Work with BCCC communications director to inform the church of next steps opportunities
- Develop and effectively manage an annual budget and ministry goals
- Other duties as assigned
