

The Fruit of the Spirit is not like an apple or a pear. It's not something you can touch with your hands. It is the character of God – attributes given to us by God's Holy Spirit. Like a light that leads the way, the Holy Spirit wants to guide us in ways that honor God. The Holy Spirit gives us this fruit by helping us live, love, and treat others the same way Jesus did.

Read John 3:16.

The love John is talking about is agape love. It's sacrificial. It gives instead of taking.

Read Matthew 22:36-39.

What is the greatest commandment? Do you love God with your whole body? With your thoughts? With your heart? How does this look in your life?

When we display the character of God, we show the world how wonderful He is. People should see God's love through us. The Bible tells us God loves us. He showed His love for us by sending Jesus to die on the cross for our sins.

Read Colossians 3:12-14.

Because God is love, we should devote ourselves to loving each other. This takes time and effort, but when we truly love God, we will want to show His love to all those around us. Sometimes we don't feel so loving, but we can always ask God to help us. When others see the love displayed in our lives, they will know that we belong to God. We are His children because His fruit (or character) shines in our lives.

Close in prayer thanking God for His unconditional love.



ADULTS

If we are truly being led by the Spirit, we should gradually be transformed more and more into the image of Jesus Christ. Paul's life illustrates how he was drastically transformed so it is not surprising that he often wrote about a new life in Christ.

The theme for the 2023 Home Devotionals is "Led by the Spirit" and each month will focus on one fruit of the Spirit from Galatians 5:22-23. "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law."

The only way to master these qualities is with the Spirit of God. He is the power source, but we must have the desire to change. Being transformed more and more like Jesus doesn't happen without you submitting to His growing you, disciplining you, and stretching you.

- Why does love lead the list?
- Some suggest that the fruit of the spirit is love and all the other qualities are expressions of love. Agree?

1 Corinthians 13 is often called the great love chapter of the Bible, and the concluding verse reads, "And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love." Take a moment and read 1 Corinthians 13:1-13.

Close in prayer thanking God for His love for you and ask Him to help you to love Him more and to love others more. Then include the following in your prayer:

- Select at least one descriptive phrase of love from 1 Corinthians
 13 that you do well and thank God for His transforming work in you.
- Select at least one phrase where you need to grow and ask God to help you.

FAMILIES WITH TEENS

How many songs can you name that have love in the title or lyrics?

What makes a song a good love song?

Unfortunately one of my favorite songs with "love" in the title is Haddaway's "What is Love" made popular by the SNL sketch featuring Will Ferrell, Chris Kattan, and Jim Carrey. I'm not sure it's worth your time to look that up, but it was peak comedy in the early 2000's.

The concept of love is tricky to define. We want to feel loved. We want to have someone to love. We know love when we see it. But how I experience or feel love may be different than your experience.

Read Galatians 5:16-26, John 13:34-35, 1 Corinthians 13:1-8

When Paul says that one of the fruits produced by the indwelling of the Holy Spirit is love, what kind of love is he talking about?

When the Spirit leads us to love others what will this look like?

What does it look like for you at school? Work? Church? Interacting with waiters/waitresses? Checking out at Wal-Mart? Running into homeless strangers?

Jesus says that love is a characteristic that defines us. It will be part of our identity. People can tell you're an athlete, cheer, are studious, or work outside based on what you wear. People should be able to tell we are followers of Jesus because of how we wear our love for others.

What are some ways your family can show love to others this week?

Are those sustainable for the rest of the year?

Spend some time meditating on when you felt the most in love with God and when you were truly showing love the most consistently.
