

## Read Daniel 6:10.


Daniel prayed and thanked God every day, even when things were hard.

## **FAMILIES WITH TEENS**

### Gratitude

As a family, take a few moments before the Thanksgiving holiday to talk about gratitude. Discuss the following questions.

- What is gratitude what does it mean to be thankful?
- Some consider pride as the opposite of gratitude. You cannot be full of pride and have a thankful heart. Do you agree?
- When is it easiest for you to be thankful?
- When is it a challenge for you to be thankful?
- Why is it best for us to be thankful and show gratifude?
- Who in your family is good at expressing gratitude?

Close by reading Colossians 3:15-17 and pray together.

"Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. <sup>16</sup>Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God. <sup>17</sup>And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."
