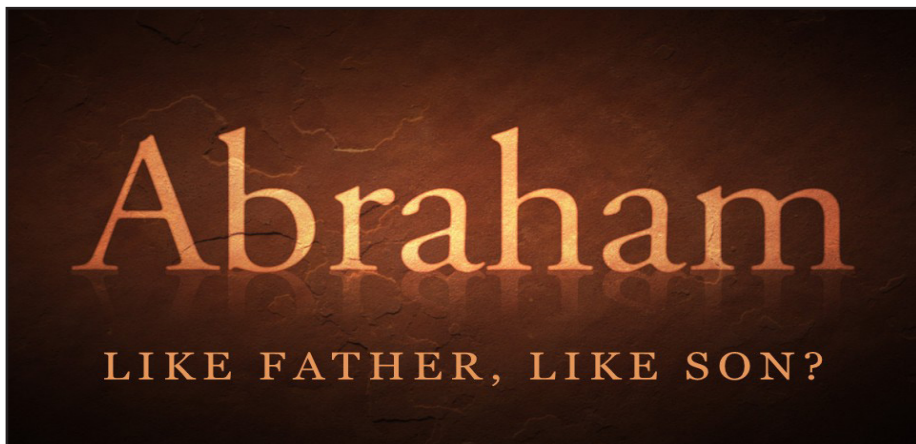

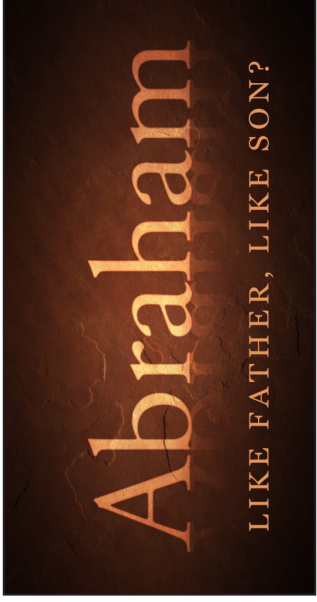

### Open

- "Like father, like son" is often stated when someone bears a strong resemblance to their father - or mother. This may be evident in a physical trait, such as height or hair color as well as temperament, disposition or mannerisms. Has anyone ever told you that you resemble your mother or father? How are you like your mom or dad?
- Is there someone you know whom you would say has faith like Abraham? If so, how do you know this to be true about them?

### Scripture, Discussion and Application

Three major religions trace their origin to Abraham - Judaism, Islam, and Christianity. Hence, "Father Abraham" is a common expression and for good reason.

The Bible refers to Abraham as a friend of God, however, he is most admired for his faith. Though he was not perfect, Abraham's life reveals a faith that is worth emulating. Since Christians are children of Abraham, should we not also be full of faith? Perhaps the words of the father in Mark 9 ring true for us as well, "I believe, help my unbelief!" Even the apostles said to Jesus, "Increase our faith" (Luke 17:5).

The morning message listed three facts about Abraham that we need today.

### Read Genesis 12:1-2.

- We don't know much about Abraham's spiritual background, so there were no strong spiritual examples for him to follow. How do you explain how Abraham was able to believe what seemed impossible?
- The Bible is full of promises. Which ones are especially meaningful to you? Do you have a favorite?
- Romans 10:17 says "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ." What does that mean? What implications does that have for someone who truly wants to grow in faith?

### Read Genesis 12:4.

- Note that his response was decisive and immediate. "So Abram went..." is an incredibly brief description for such a huge undertaking. Hebrews 11:8 shares more insight, "By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going." (You may recall that later, when God told him to offer his only son, Abram's response was again decisive and immediate.) Did Abraham know something that we do not know? How was he able to do this? How was he able to obey without knowing the details of what was ahead?

### Read Genesis 12:5-8.

"Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you" (1 Thessalonians 5:18). It is a real testimony of faith to continue to worship and obey - even though circumstances are not ideal! Why is that true?

Let Romans 4:3 summarize the life of Abraham, "For what does the Scripture say? 'Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness.'" Can the same be said of you?
