- Have you ever thrown away something that was valuable? Did you retrieve it?
- We often use the word hope to mean a wish, or a preference. How does that differ from how the word is used in Scripture?

Scripture, Discussion and Application

Begin by reviewing Chip Ingram's "Divine Equation."

- What is the message?
- Why do circumstances have so much power and influence on us?
- How have you experienced this formula to be true?

Romans 5:1-5 describes a hope that does not disappoint. "Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ²through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God. ³Not only so, but we also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; ⁴perseverance, character; and character, hope. ⁵And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us."

- Can you think of an example of unimportant moments or events when you were hopeful, but ended up being disappointed?
- Would you be willing to share a time when you were hopeful about something very important to you, but ended up being disappointed?

Read Philippians 3:1-2

• What was the challenge facing the Philippians? Do we face the same challenge today?

Read Philippians 3:3-6

 Paul had significant and powerful attributes and accomplishments to his credit. Perhaps, you do as well. Can you think of something noteworthy about yourself that others may not know?

Read Philippians 3:7-11

- Why did Paul consider these "reasons to put confidence in the flesh" as rubbish? How is that possible?
- Discuss another key word "compared" in verse 8.

Consider how verse 12 is translated in the ESV: "Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own" (Philippians 3:12). What is the comfort to be found in this statement?

Read Philippians 3:13-16

- Paul is not talking about leaving behind sins or failures in the past, though other Scriptures address that. What is to be "forgotten"?
- How do we "live up to what we have already attained"?

Read Philippians 3:20-21

What is the point of having citizenship in heaven?

CLOSE: As you close, talk about "eagerly" awaiting the return of Jesus. How should that hopeful expectation impact on our daily lives?
