Precepts Study of 1 Kings

Begin your discussion with introductions and get to know each other better. What is your goal for this group?

Scripture, Discussion and Application

Jesus said, "For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted" (Matthew 23:12). In James 4:6, James quotes Proverbs 3:34. "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." Even those with no religious convictions appreciate the offensiveness of pride and the attraction of humility. Why is this such a universal truth?

The title of this series is from 1 Peter 1:8-9. "Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, for you are receiving the goal of your faith, the salvation of your souls."

It is no surprise that a study of joy would include pride and humility. While we are all familiar with pride, it may appear in different ways. In his book, *The Life You've Always Wanted*, John Ortberg identified four types of pride. Discuss each one and why it can be so problematic.

- Vanity
- Stubbornness
- Exclusiveness
- Approval Addiction

Can you think of another? We may not struggle with all of these forms of pride, but which one gives you the most trouble?

Read Philippians 2:1-2.

"Make my joy complete" is how Paul introduces this section. What would prevent that from happening?

Read Philippians 2:3-4

• Why is this a continual challenge for us all? How can we help one another to grow in this way?

Read Philippians 2:5-8

• Jesus is the ultimate example of humility. Can we fathom what leaving heaven must have been like for Him? What do you appreciate about the humility of Jesus?

Read Philippians 2:9-11

Verse nine begins with "therefore." What is "therefore" there for? What is the point Paul is making?

Read Philippians 2:12-14

- What is the meaning of the phrase, "continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling"?
- How is pride connected with "complaining and arguing"?

Read Philippians 2:15-18

We are to "shine like stars in the universe!" What impact does humility have on our influence? What is the connection between humility and joy?

CLOSE: As you begin your SGBS meetings for the year, spend time praying together. What is competing for your joy? How can this group pray for you?
