oppressed go free, and to break every yoke? ⁷Is it not
to share your bread with the hungry, and bring the
homeless poor into your house; when you see the
naked, to cover them, and not to hide yourself from
your own kin? ⁸Then your light shall break forth like
the dawn, and your healing shall spring up quickly;
your vindicator shall go before you, the glory of the
LORD shall be your rearguard. ⁹Then you shall call, and
the LORD will answer; you shall cry for help, and he will
say, Here I am. If you remove the yoke from among

you, the pointing of the finger, the speaking of evil, ¹⁰if you offer your food to the hungry and satisfy the needs of the afflicted, then your light shall rise in the darkness and your gloom be like the noonday. ¹¹The LORD will guide you continually, and satisfy your needs in parched places, and make your bones strong; and you shall be like a watered garden, like a spring of water, whose waters never fail. ¹²Your ancient ruins shall be rebuilt; you shall raise up the foundations of many generations; you shall be called the repairer of the breach, the restorer of streets to live in.
