LIGHTING THE ADVENT CANDLE

<u>Reader</u>: Sometimes things can feel out of place, things become different than it used to be, and we

worry about the unknown and what's ahead. That uncertainty usually reminds us how much we need the Advent of God!

The prophet Isaiah cried out for us, "O that you would tear open the heavens and come down ... To make your name known ... so that nations might tremble at your presence." Sometimes we realize that we need God to break through all of the mess, to create an anxious presence, and to be among us again. "We long to be your people, O God, a people of HOPE."

We light this first candle as a sign of our HOPE even in the confusion. Hope that God can meet us, even in the mess of our world. Hope that God still sees us, though we feel we are lost in the rubble. Let this light be the guide that brings us to Emmanuel once more...and may the *GIFT* of *CHRIST* mas restore our HOPE.
