Jesus created the universe. He spun stars out across space and breathed life into everything that walks, runs, swims, and slithers. He's not just a king—he's the King of kings!

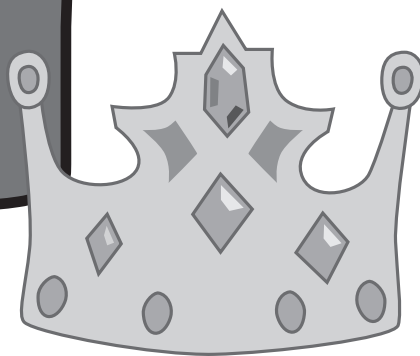
And the King knows and loves you! Wow.

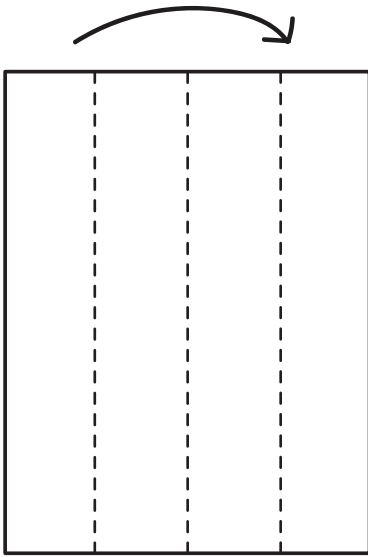
Wear this page home!

Here's how:

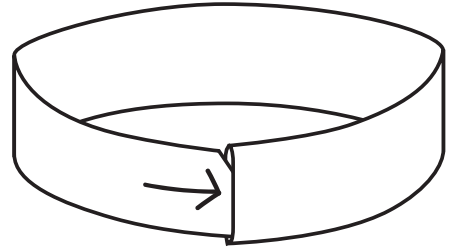
- 1 Fold over the paper at least four times, flattening folds as you go.
