T - Think & Pray! - Ask God for help. Ask yourself, "Does this choice honor God? Am I making the best choice? Am I being truthful? Am I being obedient? Does this action show self control? Am I demonstrating boldness?"

O - Options! Examine your options. If you answer positively to the questions, then it is probably a great choice. If you answer negatively to the questions, then you need to think of another option.

P - Pick! When all answers to the questions are positive, go for it! When an answer is not, pick another activity, look for another choice, choose to leave or turn it off!
