Everything we have comes from God. It is important to remember that we are only stewards of everything we have or will ever receive while here on earth. Tithing has been the traditional standard of giving in the church.

The word tithe means to deliberately and thoughtfully give 10% of our financial resources to the church as a thank offering to God. Tithing is not a law or demand on the Christian, but a discipline that is developed as a grateful response to God's grace and love for us.

10-10-10 Stewardship

As an Anglican Mission congregation, we strive to reach the 10-10-10 stewardship model in which individuals give 10% to All Saints Church, Spartanburg; the church gives 10% to the AMiA National Mission Resource Center, which in turn gives 10% to fund Anglican work around the world.

All money received at the national level is invested in expanding the Mission, as much as 50% of our national budget is directed to new initiatives and board approved strategic works, primarily starting new churches.

The remaining 40% of national funds received are used to cover other National initiatives and mission expenses. All Saints Church, Spartanburg tithes 10% of her receipts to National on a monthly basis and has since her formation in 2008.

The Operating Fund

All money received by the church is put in the operating fund. This fund pays for the general operations of the church office, program and ministry costs, staff salaries, office administration, worship supplies, and the purchasing of furniture and equipment.

All checks should be written to All Saints Church, Spartanburg or ASCS. All amounts given to the church are kept in the strictest of confidentiality by the Church Treasurer.

Contribution statements are mailed quarterly.

Designating Funds

To designate a check for a purpose other than the pledge, please do so by writing the purpose on the lower left hand corner of the check.

Planned Giving

To make arrangements for the transfer of stock, real estate, or other assets to All Saints Church, or for information on fulfilling your pledge with direct bank withdrawal, please contact the treasurer at treasurer@visitalsaints.org.

Planned giving allows you to leave a legacy to All Saints using estate-planning vehicles. When considering a planned gift, always consult with your financial, tax, and/or legal advisors.

While we recognize that people are in different places spiritually and with regard to their ability to give, we uphold the practice of the tithe to be the biblical norm. The Lord said, "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." (Matthew 6:21 NIV) Giving is one of those things that helps keep the Lord first in our lives.

Thank you for prayerfully filling out this pledge card. Our budget requires that we estimate our income in order to plan things for the coming year. Pledge cards are helpful in the process. Without them, we'll make decisions based on historical data from previous years.
