3 Steps for Good Bible Study

Discovering God's Message in God's Word Handout

OBSERVATION

Answers the question: What does the passage / text say?

Genre / form; Grammatical; Word usage; Repetition; Persons; Places; Timing; etc.

INTERPRETATION

Answers the question: What does the passage / text mean?

Original Author / Recipients; context; Words, Structure, Irregularities / Difficulties; Themes; etc. (see message and/or notes from 7/13/25)

APPLICATION (Implication of the passage)

Answers the question: How should I respond to this passage / text?

What does this teach me about God? ..Jesus Christ? ..the Holy Spirit?
What does this teach me about man? ..the church? ..sin? ..salvation? ..etc.
Is there an action or response I need to make?

(prayer, praise, confession, reconciliation, reaching out, etc.)
How should I think / feel / act differently?
Is there a promise for me to claim?
Is there an example for me to follow?
Is there something for me to avoid?
Is there a command for me to obey?
