



## Life Group FAQ's

### **What is a Life Group?**

A Life Group is made up of a small group of people (10-14 people) who want to study, grow spiritually, share, and connect with other people who are moving in the same direction in their Christian lives.

### **How do Life Groups fit into the mission and vision of CFC?**

At CFC, it is our vision to help all people find and live their lives in Christ while bridging ethnic, cultural, denominational, and generational lines. We are passionate about building diverse relationships and friendships, and sharing our lives together. Through our different perspectives we want to deepen our understanding of God's word and make it applicable to our lives.

Yes. Pulse Student Ministry meets Sunday evenings at 6:30-8:00pm. At that time they meet in small groups.

### **Why should I join a Life Group?**

Here are four very important reasons. First, you will have an opportunity to begin to understand the Bible or sermon better because you are able to ask questions. Second, you will begin to fellowship and connect and begin to feel like you're part of God's family (and not just a face in the crowd). Third, prayer will become more meaningful for you (your friends will be praying for you and with you). Finally, you'll be able to handle stress and pressure better (when your friends are there for you life is a very different experience).

### **What happens at a Life Group meeting?**

Most groups have a time allowed for fellowship, which gives you an opportunity to build relationships. The central component is the sermon-based discussion which allows for you to dive deeper into God's Word. Our groups are designed to encourage discussion and engage each person in the process. And then our groups have an opportunity to pray for each other.

### **How long does a group last?**

Life Groups meet on a weekly basis for 10-week trimesters in the winter, spring, and fall, with the summer and the holiday season off.
