1. What did Zacchaeus do that made people angry? (Tax collector that stole money)
2. Where did Jesus find Zacchaeus? (In a tree)
3. Why was Zacchaeus in the tree? (To see Jesus over the crowd)
4. Do you think Jesus knew Zacchaeus stole money? (Yes)
5. How did Jesus treat Zacchaeus? (He forgave him and asked him to come out of the tree so he could go to his house with him)
6. What happened to Zacchaeus after spending time with Jesus? (His heart changed and he gave back all the money he had stolen and more!)
7. How can we be like Jesus when our friends hurt our feelings or take our toys? (Forgive them and be kind)
8. Who does Jesus love? (Everyone!)
9. Does anyone remember the memory verse? "Love each other (*give yourself a big hug*) as I (*point up with both fingers*) have loved you, (*bring fingers down and point all over the room at all the kids*), John 15:12." (*Open your hands like a book.*)
