

Church Re-Opening With the Newly Release Guidelines
Our New Protocols - Medical Response and Safety Team
June 11, 2020

The Medical Response and Safety Team of Innisfil Community Church has indicated support to re-open church on Sunday, June 21, 2020 with the following safety controls and practices in place.

- 1) Entrances and Exits will be separated and clearly marked to prevent cross intersection of congregants.
- 2) An Usher will be assigned to each entry
 - The Entry Usher will:
 - 1) Wear a mask
 - 2) Prop doors open to avoid un-necessary multiple points of contact
 - 3) Dispense alcohol based Hand Cleanser to each attendee
 - 4) Direct people to Physically Distance
 - 5) Point out the Safety protocol sign
- 3) Upstair and Downstairs will be closed off
- 4) Pedestrian Traffic Flow on the inside will be in a counter-clockwise format alleviating cross intersection of congregants
- 5) There will be No Kids Program at this time - (In development for future)
- 7) No Coffee or Food will be served
- 8) No passing the offering plate - Drop box giving only
- 9) Bathroom Attendant
 - An Usher will be assigned to periodically sanitize surface areas including door handles, flush handles, sink knobs and handles, etc. with lysol wipes
 - Signs will be posted indicating Hand Washing by users after use is required.
- 10) Debit Machine sanitizing- Lysol wipes will be provided and signage to request donors to use wipes before and after the use of debit machine
(An usher will assist.)
- 10) Physical distancing will be encourage throughout the building, and marking will be placed on the floor surfaces to assist.
- 11) Lingering at the end of services is strongly discouraged.

Additional Information:

1) Extra Signage required

3- Entrance Signs - Large

(Outside Courtyard Entry, Office Entry, Carport Entry)

3- Exit Signs - Large

(Carport Exit inside & outside, East Exit to parking lot)

3- Health protocol Signs

1- Hand washing sign

2) Temperature Taken upon entry for Congregants is NOT required at this time
(although office staff do log their information)

- If this changes we will need 3 additional digital distance thermometer

3) Attendance Tracking In case of Covid-19 Virus spread, for notification purposes

- Currently we use Video surveillance in the building. The camera at the entry to sanctuary should serve this purpose if we need to do any future tracking.)

4) Sanctuary Seating physically is distanced with Family seating of 5, 4, 3. (See diagram)

Covid-19 Church Layout with Physically Distancing



59 separate seating areas - 16 @ 5 persons (family) 18 @ 4 persons and 25 @ 3 persons

Full seating - $80 + 72 + 75 = 227$

Capacity 700 normally - 30% = 210
