

The Clothing Depot to Re-Open

Covid-19 Precautions Taken

The re-opening of The Clothing Depot is being done with Covid-19 Precautions in place.

- 1) The space has been altered to provide wider aisles for shoppers.
- 2) Used clothing will not be sorted immediately, but will remain untouched for 24 hours as recommended by the protocols of the Province of Saskatchewan and the company McCarthy Tétrault.
- 3) Shopping will be done by appointment with no more than 8 shoppers in at any given time.
- 4) Shoppers will be allowed a maximum of 1 full bag of clothes.
- 5) Sorting will be done primarily in the mornings.
- 6) Shopping will take place on Thursday afternoon and evenings, by appointment.
- 7) Volunteers will be encouraged to use sanitizer frequently, and additional safety measures are encouraged for volunteers including the use of gloves and masks (or face coverings). These items will be provided free and available at all times in the Clothing Depot.
