Water Baptism

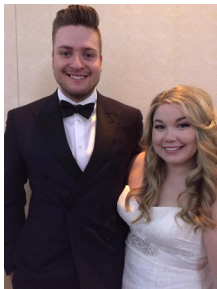

COMING ON JUNE 4TH



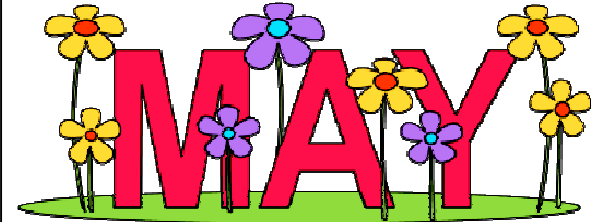

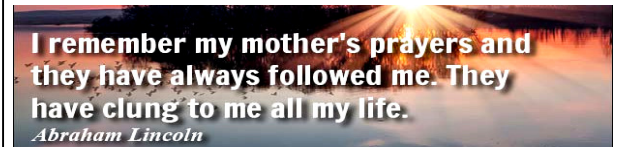
May Flowers and Mother's Day

The baseball season has begun, in competition

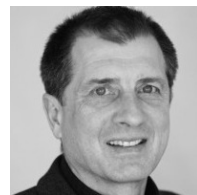
