EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3

WHEREAS, On March 26, 2020 the City of Ellisville, in accordance with Section 33-15-17(d), Mississippi Code 1972, as amended, declared that a State of Emergency exists in the city resulting from the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the global outbreak of COVID-19 and the effects of its extreme risk of person-to-person transmission throughout the United States, Mississippi, Jones County, and Ellisville significantly impact the life and health of our citizens as well as our local economy; and

WHEREAS, THE City of Ellisville has received guidance from the Mississippi Department of Health, local health officials, the Jones County Emergency Operations Center, the Centers for Disease Control and through Executive Orders by Governor Tate Reeves; and


WHEREAS, additional measures are needed to further disrupt and slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus within the State and City to manage needed healthcare and emergency management resources; accordingly, all individuals residing in the City of Ellisville should continue to adhere to the guidelines as given in the Governor's Executive Orders.

WHEREAS, the Governor's Executive Order 1492, as amended and extended by Executive Orders 1496, 1500, 15005, 1508, 1511, 1514, 1516, 1518 and 1519 has been further extended by Executive Order 1520 and remains in full force and effect until 8:00 a.m. on Monday, September 14, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Lynn A. Buckhaults, Mayor of the City of Ellisville, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor and by the laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby order and direct in the City of Ellisville, effective at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 1, 2020 and continuing until Monday at 8:00 a.m. September 14, 2020 unless rescinded, modified or extended, the Governor's Executive Order 1520 amending Order 1519. The City of Ellisville fully supports and adopts by reference the Governor's Order as stated herein above, including but not limited to the guidelines regarding the wearing of masks and social distancing. This order is further extended, modified or rescinded in conjunction with any further Executive Orders by the Governor.
