

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WATER,
SEWER, AND GARBAGE RATES FOR
THE CITY OF ELLISVILLE, MISSISSIPPI**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ELLISVILLE, MISSISSIPPI:

**WATER RATES
(Inside City)**

Minimum charges	2,000 gallons or less	\$17.00
Next	4,000 gallons	\$ 3.00 per thousand
All over	6,000 gallons	\$ 2.30 per thousand

**WATER RATES
(Outside City)**

Minimum charges	2,000 gallons or less	\$34.00
Next	4,000 gallons	\$ 3.00 per thousand
All over	6,000 gallons	\$ 2.30 per thousand

SEWER RATES

Residential	2,000 gallons or less	\$16.00
	All above 2,000 gallons	A base rate of \$16.00 plus 70% of all water used above 2,000 gallons
Commercial	2,000 gallons or less	\$16.00
	All above 2,000 gallons	A base rate of \$16.00 plus 70% of all water used above 2,000 gallons

SECTION II: Be it further ordered that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herein be and the same are hereby repealed, and

SECTION III: Be it further ordered that you must establish an account with the City in order to dispose of waste; and that prior to disposal, you must contact City Hall and the Public Works Director.

SECTION IV: Dumping is limited to Port-o-Let/Septic Tank waste. Violation of this policy will result in termination of privileges.


SECTION V: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect as to all matters contained therein on and after the 6th day of September, 2018.
