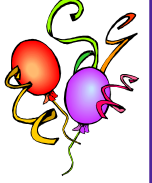
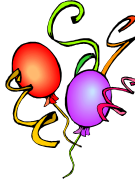

### **Senior Adult Fellowship Monthly Potluck Meeting Minutes August 23, 2018 11:30 – 1:00 PM-Social Center-FBC**

- Pre-gathering was music provided by Mrs. Glenda Copass.
- The welcome was given by David Tooley. He informed the group that the Hayward Brown Banquet has been scheduled for Thursday, November 8<sup>th</sup>. Christian comedian, Dennis Swanberg, will be providing the entertainment.
- Pledges to the American and Christian flags were led by William Neel, Jr.
- The group sang “My Country Tis of Thee” and “Onward Christian Soldiers”.
- Prayer of thanksgiving for the meal was voiced by David Tooley.
- Table assignments were done by Betty Stahl.
- After the meal there was recognition of August birthdays by Betty Johnson. The group sang “Happy Birthday.”
- David Tooley introduced the speaker for today, Nancy Rice, Ph.D. The title of Dr. Rice’s talk was “Partners in Caring: Medicine in Kenya; Ten years of missions in Kasigau, Kenya”. Connections to the community (Western Kentucky University, First Baptist Church and other Bowling Green communities) were discussed. She discussed the importance of funding for this mission. Dr. Rice stated that Kenya is a model of a developing nation in East Africa, however, its people still require much assistance with their health needs and daily living issues. High unemployment and HIV/AIDS was discussed. Slides of various villages and relief efforts were shown. These included medical screenings, assistance with medications, providing educational opportunities for children, helping the local economy by the purchase of handmade baskets which are sold here in the United States. Money from the sales are fed back into the communities and people in need. Several stories of individual families were provided.
- David Tooley thanked Dr. Rice for her presentation. He informed the group that the September program will be provided by Dr. Melinda Joyce with regards to medications and their interactions. He dismissed the meeting with a prayer.
- Joe Johnson reported money available before the meeting was \$180. \$70 was taken in and \$40 spent on kitchen staff leaving a cash balance on hand of \$210.
