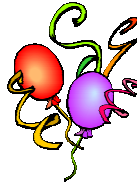

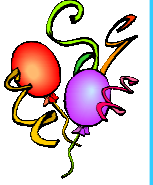

- Pledges to the American and Christian flags led by William Neel

- Recognition of guests and those having birthdays/anniversaries—Sandra Webb. The group sang Happy Birthday/ Anniversary to those celebrating these events. Sandra also provided cards for the group to sign to be sent to shut-ins.
- Prayer of thanksgiving for the meal—Dr. Reynolds
- After the meal Pastor Jeff did a program, “Your Faith Legacy”. He said everyone leaves a legacy.
