**Meeting called to order** - 6:35 pm

## Search Committee - Jill Robinson:

Jessica Gemm posted a digital version of the draft of the church profile on the FCUCC website and the committee has been receiving feedback. The Search Committee will do a group edit in their meeting next week. They hope to have a final draft by the end of March. They'll send it through to Nayiri and then it goes to Rev. Sue Artt – Conference Minister of the Rocky Mountain Conference (RMC) of the UCC. Sue and Nayiri then guide the next phases which share the profile with the Council and the Congregation. Nayiri suggested ways to get the profile reviewed and get feedback from the Congregation. It is posted thru UCC but it is not accepting applications until we send in our profile however there are already applications pending the position officially being opened. In the process, Sue recommends to check candidate references first. Once the Search Committee is in full agreement about the final candidate, they will navigate the covenant of bringing that person to the Council and then to the church. The process is going well and the committee is running very smoothly. They inadvertently missed this month's Communicator so they set up a system to not let that happen again.

## TREASURER:

Mike - Chris' Worship and Spiritual Life report announced hiring an organist, David Acton. Kudos to Mandy and Nayiri on the hiring of David. Mike said the combined effect of David also filling the administrative position saves \$20k. Congregational Nurse - there is a lingering concern over liability. The consensus is that the concern is more staff based and so staff should address those concerns. Revenue/pledges are up and expenses are down-up a little on Mission Giving. Ruth had nothing to add.

### **SECRETARY:**

Lisa brought up the possibility of buying the building on the NW corner of our block. Nayiri suggested its better left for the new pastor. It was suggested we create a task force to look into it though from a visioning standpoint.
