Our Chapel Team led us in a time of praise and worship, and we concluded the night by celebrating the retirement of our former principal, Mrs. Adams, who never got a proper sendoff in 2020 due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

We also equip students to seek knowledge through rigorous academics and engaging, experiences. hands-on learning Our for curricula standards state meet instruction, preparing students to successfully transition to public or private middle school after 6th grade.

We are proud to remain a top academic performer among local and state districts, consistently exceeding benchmarks on both ILEARN and IREAD assessments. This year, we introduced IREAD testing to our 2nd graders for the first time, and an impressive 58% passed a full year before the required testing window in 3rd grade.

Beyond state standards, our students continue to excel through ACSI academic enrichment opportunities. This year, one of our students placed 7th in the International Spelling Bee, and two of our math scholars went on to rank in the top 25% globally at the ACSI Math Competition.

By Our Love Project is a school-wide, cross-curricular project based on John 13:35; which reminds us that we will be recognized as Christ-followers by our love for each other, by noticing a need and helping to authentically address that need in a meaningful way. This project allows students to put faith into action by loving others.

THE NEED

The Warehouse is a local organization meeting the needs of Bloomington residents through safe indoor recreation for all ages, while sharing the love of Jesus. The Warehouse was in need of a complete renovation of their toddler area to provide a safe and clean place for toddlers in the community to play.

LEARNING SUMMARY

Students learned how to source highly nutritious greens through a complex indoor hydroponics system at Gen215. Gen215 operates out of The Warehouse as a source of revenue. Students learned about self sustaining ecosystems, aquaponics, diet and nutrition, and how to propagate plants, using Marah Water from Gen215.

SERVICE SUMMARY

CCCS families gathered together at The Warehouse to learn about Gen215 and to fundraise for the renovation of the soft space play area for children 3 and under. We raised \$10,000 alongside Embassy Church, and the renovation turned a worn down and constricted play area into a beautiful, open, and safe soft play space for children to play under a beautiful mural of God's creation.







THE ACSI ACCREDITATION TEAM VISITED CCCS IN THE SPRING OF 2025 TO CONDUCT AN AUDIT OF THE SCHOOL. USING A RIGOUROUS PROTOCOL THAT ALIGNS WITH ACSI'S RESEARCH ON FLOURISHING SCHOOLS, THEY CAREFULLY EVALUATED US THROUGH 6 DOMAINS: PURPOSE, RELATIONSHIPS, TEACHING AND LEARNING, EXPERTISE, RESOURCES, AND WELL BEING. BELOW IS THEIR SUMMARY.

At the heart of CCCS is a strong and unwavering sense of mission. Everything they do is rooted in a clear purpose: to nurture students academically, spiritually, and emotionally in a Christ-centered environment.
