

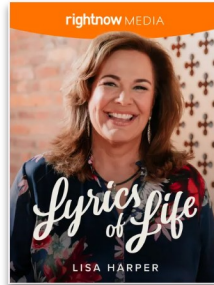

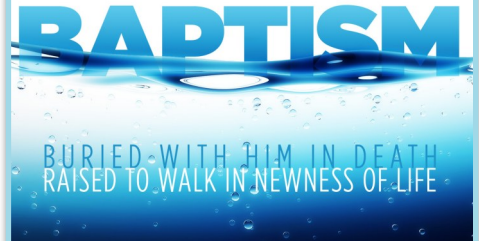

During the last few weeks of May, as VBS approached, I had multiple people come up to me and say something like, “Are you ready for VBS?” Some asked this question, with an attitude of what I’ll describe as mischievous glee. These folks had the same look that a parent gives their child when he is trying something for the first time that he doesn’t know will humble him but needs that very humility.

Having been involved in student ministry for many years, I was probably more prepared for VBS than some people realized. Student and children’s ministry events have similar hallmarks; they are usually chaotic and loud.

While VBS was chaotic and loud as I expected, it was also organized and appropriate. I will elaborate on these two aspects of VBS in the form of praises.

1. I praise God for the organized chaos of VBS. Kelly and her team did a wonderful job planning and leading. In particular, their vision for drop off and pickup worked tremendously. The kids were led around the campus in an efficient and safe manner. From snacks, to crafts, to music, and Bible study VBS was successful due to the tireless efforts of Kelly and her army of servants. In fact, only one kid got lost and it was one of mine. I will also say he was missing for about five seconds, and it was completely his fault.
2. I praise God for an appropriately loud VBS. The energy in the sanctuary was palpable. The kids were excited to be there and God-honoring in their enthusiasm. They had the opportunity to genuinely and wholeheartedly worship God. The kids had a blast and so did I.

The theme verse for VBS was John 8:12, it says, “Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, ‘I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.’” Let’s take a cue from Kelly and her team and walk in the light with intentionality and enthusiasm.

Helping Teens Grow Spiritually and Practically

Teenagers today are growing up in a world where screens are almost always within reach. Phones, games, streaming, and social media can be fun, helpful, and even useful for staying connected. But when screen time takes over too much of life, students can miss out on learning the real-life skills they need to grow into wise, capable, and Christ centered adults.

Learning life skills is not just about “adulting.” It is part of **discipleship**.

The Bible reminds us in Luke 2:52 that “*Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man.*” Jesus grew spiritually, mentally, physically, and socially. That gives us a helpful picture for teenagers today. God cares about their whole life, not just what happens at church on Wednesday night or Sunday morning.

Life skills help teenagers grow in responsibility. When a student learns how to cook a simple meal, manage money, do laundry, change a tire, communicate respectfully, or keep a schedule, they are learning stewardship. These things may not feel “spiritual” at first, but they help students become dependable, thoughtful, and prepared.

Too much screen time can quietly work against that growth. It can train teenagers to expect constant entertainment, quick answers, and instant feedback. Real life usually does not work that way. Learning a skill takes patience, practice, failure, and humility. Those are all things God uses to shape character.

Life skills also build confidence. Many teenagers feel anxious about the future because they have not had many chances to practice handling real responsibilities. Giving students opportunities to solve problems, serve others, and try new things helps them discover that they are more capable than they realized. More importantly, it teaches them to depend on God while taking faithful steps forward.

Life skills also create opportunities to love and serve others. A student who can cook can bless a family. A student who can budget can give generously. A student who knows how to have a face-to-face conversation can encourage a hurting friend and share their testimony. A student who learns basic work skills can honor God in a job. These are not just practical abilities; they are tools for ministry.

This does not mean every screen is bad. Technology can be a gift when it is used wisely. The goal is not to shame teenagers for using phones or enjoying games. The goal is to help them ask a better question: “Is this helping me become the person God is calling me to be?”

Teenagers do not need less fun. They need more formation. They need adults who will patiently teach them, encourage them, and remind them that following Jesus affects every part of life. They need a community to help them navigate deeper thinking.

Screens may keep students entertained, but life skills help them become equipped. And our prayer is not just that teenagers would be entertained for the moment, but that they would be prepared to follow Jesus faithfully for a lifetime.

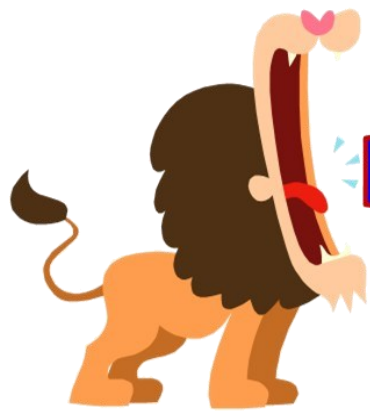


