



Barnabas and Paul

Acts 9:26-28, 11:22-26, 15:36-40

I preached a message on friendship recently. There's much we can continue to learn from Paul and Barnabas, including how to handle conflict among friends. Let me start with this question...Isn't it encouraging to read about the conflict between Paul and Barnabas? What?! How can their disagreement be encouraging? Critics and skeptics attack the Bible with striking regularity. One of the arguments they make is that the Bible is merely a compilation of contrived stories to serve a religious purpose rather than eye-witness accounts of actual events. If this was the case, then why would Luke, the author of Acts, describe this disagreement in such detail? He wouldn't. This narrative and others like it serve as affirmations of the reliability of Scripture.

Those of us that believe in the infallibility of the Bible don't necessarily need evidence of the accuracy of the Word of God. We already have a high view of Scripture. It is encouraging to be reminded of the historical precision of biblical accounts. We can also learn a great deal from the way God worked through real, flawed, sinful people in Bible times. A brief glimpse into Barnabas' part in this story will help us as we are seeking to be faithful as Christ-followers today.

Barnabas came to Antioch with gladness and "exhorted them all to remain faithful to the Lord" (Acts 11:23). The Greek word for exhorted is *parakaleo* (par-ak-al-eh'-o) and is also translated "encouragement." Obviously, Joseph of Cyprus (Acts 4:36) was such an encourager he received the nickname Barnabas, which means 'son of encouragement'. When it came to encouragement, this guy was a special case. But we should all have a bit of Barnabas in us. **We must realize that speaking encouragement to others is obedience to God's Word.** It is easy to view Barnabas as such a unique example that we miss out on the reality that God expects us to be the same way. The Greek word for exhorted is used over a hundred times in the New Testament. One of those instances is Hebrews 3:13. This verse provides an urgent command to exhort one another to remain faithful, just like Barnabas did with the believers in Antioch.

Much is made of the division between Paul and Barnabas. These two men loved Jesus, loved His church, and were seeking to be a blessing to other believers. The reality that they came to an impasse should be a sobering reminder to us of our own fallenness. Because we are fallen people in a fallen world, there will be conflict. Heaven is the only place where there won't be the potential for discord. In the meantime, we must prepare our hearts to be gracious, patient, and as far as it depends on us live peaceably with all (Romans 12:18).

Barnabas, for his part, saw potential in Mark and wanted to bring him along to do the work of the ministry. We again, should strive to be like Barnabas. **Seeing beyond surface level conflict to potential in others is an important aspect of fellowship and peacemaking.** We can develop this kind of perspective by remembering the grace that we have received from God. Ephesians 4:32 provides a biblical framework for applying this principle. We should be kind, tenderhearted, and forgiving based upon the reality that God has done the same for us. How can we withhold from others that which we have received from God?





Let's be real: life is a lot right now. Between the constant notifications, the pressure to "level up," and the general chaos of the world, it's no wonder our mental health takes a hit. We've got apps for meditation and shelves full of self-help books, but sometimes it feels like we're just putting a Band-Aid on a much deeper wound.

If you're feeling overwhelmed, here's a perspective that's been a lifeline for millions: **the peace that comes from knowing Jesus**. It's not about being "religious" or checking boxes; it's about a real relationship with God that changes how you see yourself and your stress.

Most of our anxiety comes from the "Performance Trap." We feel like we're only as good as our last win, our latest post, or our bank account balance.

- **The World says:** "Do more, be more, then you'll matter."

Jesus says: "You already matter because I made you and I love you."

When you realize your value is locked in and can't be taken away by a bad day or a mistake, the "hustle" stops being a source of panic and starts being just... life. **You're working from love, not for it.**

A huge chunk of stress is just us trying to control things we actually can't. We play "what if" games in our heads until we're exhausted.

Faith is basically the ultimate "delete" key for that stress. There's a famous invite in the Bible that says: *"Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you"* (1 Peter 5:7). It's like having a best friend who also happens to run the universe. You can vent, let it out, and trust that He's got the big picture handled, even when you don't.

Mental health struggles can feel like wasted time. You feel "behind" or broken. But in the Christian faith, **nothing is wasted**. Jesus wasn't a stranger to pain; He went through the worst of it. Because of that, He's right there with you in the middle of the mess. Faith gives you the hope that your current struggle isn't the end of your story—it's just a chapter that's shaping you into someone more resilient and compassionate.

One thing to clear up: **Faith isn't a replacement for professional help**. Think of it like this:

- **The Spiritual Side:** Prayer and faith give you an anchor and a "why" for living.

The Practical Side: Therapy and doctors give you the "how" to navigate your brain's chemistry and habits.

God created the people who study the mind, too! Using every tool available—prayer, community, and counseling — is the best way

to take care of the "temple" that is your body, mind, and soul.

If your head is spinning today, take a breath. You don't have to have it all figured out to talk to God. You can literally just start with, *"Jesus, I'm stressed and I need some peace"*. He's a lot better at listening than the internet is.

Jesus said, *"Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid"* (John 14:27).




