MEN'S MINISTRY BIBLE STUDY

New Bible Study – Session 1
Monday, October 13 – 6PM, Kidd Street Center
Facilitated by Ed Klink/Dinner provided

Paul gives instructions in Ephesians 6:10-18 on wearing, using, and honoring the armor of God. In this series, Pastor Bill Search teaches sessions on how to stand strong during the challenges of life by properly putting on the Armor of God.

Men's Ministry meets on the 2nd Monday of each month.

We are living in a day that seems to be defined by deepening darkness. The growing depth of spiritual darkness was recently put on display by the horrific murder of Charlie Kirk. Maybe better known for his fearlessness in debating political issues, Kirk should be best known for his bold faith in Jesus Christ. Not very long before Kirk lost his life, he was asked how he would want to be remembered. He replied, "I want to be remembered for courage for my faith. The most important thing is my faith." To Kirk, his influence in the political arena was secondary to his eternally significant impact with the Gospel.

We should lament and pray for a society that seeks to silence the truth and celebrates violence. At the same time, the church should recognize and take advantage of the opportunities a dark day provides. The darker the day, the brighter our light can shine.

The Oxford dictionary defines light as, "The natural agent that stimulates sight and makes things visible." We find Jesus praying in John 17:22. The Son of God intercedes for future believers this way, "The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one." As I preached a few Sundays ago, the church is responsible to reveal the glory of God to the world. We must take the responsibility to make the glory of God visible seriously! We must be a light!

God gives us the blueprint to be the kind of church that reveals His glory to the world in Acts 2:42-47. As you read this article, I'm in the middle of preaching through this passage on Sunday mornings. Prayerfully prepare to hear these messages on the church each Sunday.

You can start to shine that light now. Once again, I want to turn to the Kirk's as an example of how to show that our God, the one true God, is different. I would expect a young grieving widow to condemn the man that assassinated her husband. In one of the most moving and profound public moments I've ever seen, Erika Kirk did the exact opposite. She said this about the man that shot and killed her husband "That man, that young man, I forgive him. I forgive him because it's what Christ did and it's what Charlie would do." Erika Kirk revealed the glory of God by showing the nature of His grace to a watching world.

Are their people in your life that you need to forgive? If granting forgiveness reveals the glory of God, then holding grudges and withholding forgiveness conceals it. Follow Erika's example of generously and radically forgiving others. Even if relational reconciliation comes later (if ever) you can still show what God is like by granting to others the same kind of forgiveness that you have received from Him.






