

1 CROSS

The Cross is pictured here as a living tree, reminding us of the Tree of Life. Furthermore, the Cross provides us with life, as it becomes a tree of life to those who believe.

2 COLORS

The colored leaves remind us that the nations are in need of the Cross. Furthermore, they represent seasons, reminding us that time rushes on, that time is short, and the harvest is plentiful. We must have a sense of urgency to reach the nations with the Gospel of Christ.

3 CIRCLE

The symbol progresses from the Cross which gives life (at the center) to the leaves, reminding us to fulfill our mission to the world. (circle=eternity, unity, world)
