Last Week Monique had her first scan after starting her third type of Chemo Treatment.

She saw her oncologist this past Wednesday before she had her next Chemo treatment. He was so pleased telling her that the nodules had shrunk. This means that the chemo is working and that she will continue as long as it continues to either reduce the nodule more or maintain them at this level. The cancer in her bones in her lower back stayed the same, not growing as in the past.

The main side effect remains the constant fatigue and extreme body aches. She also has a bit of neuropathy in her hands and feet, but not enough to affect her use of her hands and feet. She can still drive her car and does what she needs with her hands. All this is not the best, yet so much better than all the breathing problems, having to use oxygen, and the nausea problems she had with the other types of Chemo treatments.

A year ago we were devastated by the possibility of her imminent death. The Lord has done great things in answering our united prayers. We are so thankful for you and all our prayer support groups around the world. You all are a vital part of those groups.

It is still a day by day situation. We are grateful to the Lord for everyday that He gives us with Monique.
