Any cold she has seems to linger on for quite a while as her immune system has been compromised because of the Chemo treatments she is doing. Her next Chemo treatment will be on the 10th of April.

I will be having an MRI done on the 10 of April also. Since January, I have been noticing that I have lost my taste in food. All foods that taste the same. The last time I had COVID was when we both had it back in 2021, so that has been ruled out. My specialist wants to do an MRI and other tests to see if he can find the reason for this change. He also noticed that I have a balance problem that I have had for quite a while but now required the use of a cane. He hopes these tests will reveal the reason for what is happening at this time.

We continue to praise the Lord for the measure of health that He gives us each day to be able to be Monique's caregivers at this time.

We would ask that you continue to pray for Monique in her battle with cancer. It has been since January 2023 now. She is such an encouragement to us and others with her upbeat attitude with what is happening with her. She does have some bad times especially when she has a bad cold along with the side effects of the Chemo, together with the tiredness she has all the time.

Thank you, the knowledge of your praying for us means a lot to us. It helps each of us to keep moving forward whether it is Monique with

Chemo treatments; Carol and I who are her caregivers and with Michelle who knows the suffering that her sister is going through at this time.
