Parents and students have affirmed the idea and Northbrook is open to it. The Youth Pastor there, Andrew Ross, has let us see some of his teaching material, and it is quite good. The next steps are for our Leadership and CE Teams to meet with Pastor Frank Gomes (Lead Pastor) and Pastor Andrew Ross (Youth Pastor) on May 7, and then for both church leadership teams to meet and work out details. Assuming all goes well, the partnership would begin this summer. Input is always welcome, and we will continue to search for our own Youth Director, in the event that God has someone in mind for us.

Starting next week, Pastor Steve will preach a series on **vision**, which has been much in the minds of Leadership Team members these last few months. In the summer he will do a series of **People's Choice messages**. This is your chance to suggest a passage or topic of interest! They will begin on June 11.
