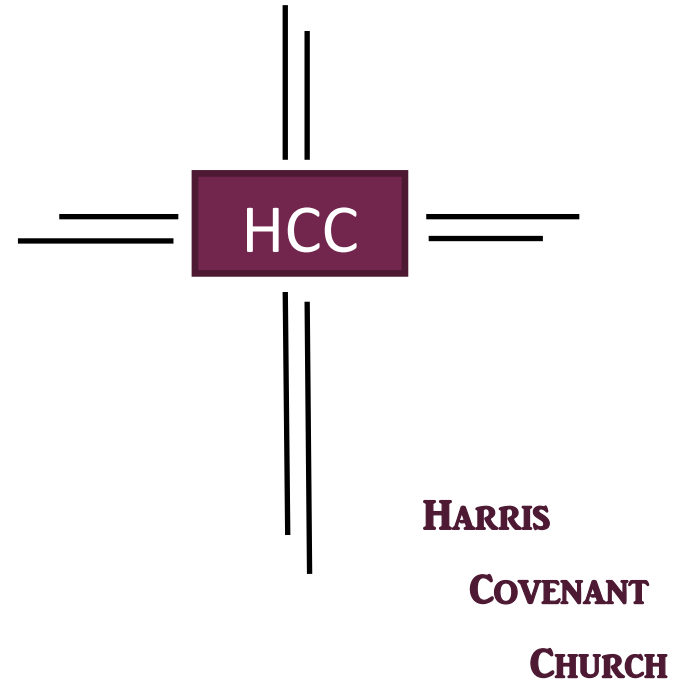

"Loving God and Loving Others"

The 30-Seconds Rule is a commitment to stop at specific times in the flow of a day to recalibrate our hearts and eyes toward the people around us. It is time to allow the Holy Spirit to tune us in to what he would have us do and who he would have us love. It's a chance to say to God, "Here I am. I'm ready to scatter the seed of your gospel. Please use me as a conduit of your living water to help seed grow." When we hit the pause button on our day, the whole direction of our lives can change. The 30-Seconds Rule is so simple, anyone can do it. In the course of your day, just make time to stop for thirty seconds and ask these three simple questions: 1. What would the Spirit of God prompt me to pray as I walk into this portion of my day? 2. Who does God want me to notice right now? 3. How might I extend the love of God and the grace of Jesus to this situation?
