I hardly could have imagined such a wide range of experiences: from being in the dunking tank at the church carnival, to accompanying the carillon service person up into the church steeple to inspect the bells, to participating in mission venues both locally and in other states, to preparing cantatas and concerts, to leading a Wesleyan heritage / choir tour to Great Britain!

It has been a privilege to be part of such a dynamic church staff. I am grateful for these colleagues for their friendship, collaboration, and support. I am also grateful to have served with senior pastors from Jody Seymour through David Christy and Matthew Burton.

I would especially like to thank my colleagues on the music & worship ministry staff: Susan Lisle, Timothy Scruggs, Aaron Prillaman, James Smith, Don Turner, Laura Beatty, Lisa Jurs, and all the helpers that make youth and children's choirs happen!

Patti and I are building a house in Morganton, NC and will be moving there in several months. We plan a garden plot in the backyard! The neighborhood is not far from Lake James, where we look forward to sailing. We also look forward to participating in ministries in that community. Morganton is only an hour's drive from Gastonia, and we invite you to visit! We also look forward to staying in touch with you.

From the main parking lot on the west side of the Sanctuary (near Franklin Blvd) you can really see the new entrance and drop off! The church has worked with the City of Gastonia to provide additional parking lot lights, too, for added safety and security.

On the east side of the campus, the new entrance looks awesome with the interior lights on. We intend to keep the new gathering space partially lit at night, as the LED lights use so little electricity and provide additional security and a nice visual element for passersby. 


