Luke 1:46-47 – "And Mary said: My soul glorifies the Lord and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior..."

We LOVE Christmas! Vibrant red and forest green colors surrounding everything, banister railings covered in greenery and twinkling lights, carols playing everywhere we go. This time of year, seems like it is sprinkled with celebration. While Christmas decorations and holiday festivities already surround us, we have not yet actually arrived at Christmas.

November 27, 2022, marks the beginning of Advent, the 'New Year's Day' of the Christian calendar. We begin the Christian year with Advent, as a way through which we begin with the end in mind. 



I recently read a synopsis of the phrase "Three Word Theology" by Diana Butler Bass. She is an award-winning author and holds a Ph.D. in religious studies from Duke University. The Embrace women's group, led by Cathy Waufle is studying her book Freeing Jesus this semester. I also shared some of the three word theology with the Prayer Pause small group. We chose to look at phrases like:

"Don't be afraid" "Be the light" "Walk in light",

"Here am I" "Do unto others" "Love your neighbors".

It's basically taking a scripture and paring it down to three significant words. By doing a little research of the scriptures, these concise words can offer great wisdom. I encourage you to pick one of these phrases or create one of your own choosing. As we enter the Advent season, think how you can live out your three word theology daily. Here are some examples:

Come, Let Us (Isaiah 1:18) Walk In Light (John 12:35) Of The Lord (Matthew 7:8)

We are still (Psalm 46:10)
We are silent (Proverbs 17:28)
And we wait (Psalm 27:14)

May your Advent season be bright with hope and light. Becky



### Charge Conference Recap

First UMC hosted and participated in the Gaston County Missional Network Charge Conference on Sunday, November 6th. James and Jane Smith provide a hymn sing to get us all started. District Superintendent, Rev. David Christy, preached and led us in Holy Communion, and presided over the Charge Conference. First UMC with unanimous joy approved Dr. Leigh Smith as a continuing candidate for ministry, approved clergy salaries, and our church leadership team to date. Below is Rev. Melissa and Justin's pastoral report presented at Charge Conference. There is much to celebrate happening in the life of First UMC!

### Pastor's Annual Charge Conference Report

First UMC is deeply committed to the mission of making disciples for the transformation of the world. We are a downtown church worshiping and serving God in the heart of our community. First UMC remains a steadfast continuing UMC Church. In July of this year, new pastoral leadership was received. As new pastors, we participated in an onboarding experience with the lay leadership and staff, lead by Rev. Kim Ingram, which has provided clarity around bright spots and growth opportunities for our church.


One of these bright spots with First UMC has been the warm welcome of the church, at the "Mingle with the Ministers" gatherings. We have had 25 "Mingle with the Ministers" so far since we arrived in July, and have several more planned through the reminder of 2022. At these events, we are able to engage folks deeper and learn their stories. We have asked two questions at each mingle: "What do you love about First UMC?", and "What dreams is God stirring in your heart for First UMC?", followed by a time of question and answer. At each gathering, the people of First UMC have expressed the deep love and community that they have found and formed at this congregation.

An opportunity that was identified from our onboarding experience was that during the pandemic, the church was not able to hug or offer a handshake, look a departing pastor or worship staff member in the eye in-person and give thanks for their ministry due to the pandemic of COVID-19. Due to this, the Staff Parish Relations Committee will be hosting two 'Giving Thanks' receptions for Rev. David Christy, Rev. Dr. Jim Westmoreland, Rev. Saxon Scarborough and Dr. Aaron Prillaman to do just that.

We are humbled and grateful to be part of this vibrant, called, community of followers of Jesus who are passionate about their relationship with Christ and reaching out to share God's love generously.
