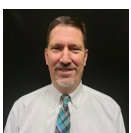

We are ready in the Catawba Valley District to begin registering our Lay Servants in the online database. Many of you may have begun this process last year, and may have partial information already entered. To register for this 2019 Charge Conference year, please use the following steps.

Go to the People Dashboard, www.wnccumc.org/peopledashboard

Log in.

If you began this process earlier *and you created a log in* then sign in using those credentials you created at that time

If you have not created log in credentials at an earlier time, sign in using the following:

Username: first initial, last name, ex. JAlexander

Password: servant123

If you have any trouble logging in, please email me for help. I fully expect there to be some issues at first, so don't hesitate to reach out!

Once you log in, you can change the username and/or password to whatever you wish

Click on "Update LSM Data"

Click on the green "Update" button to make changes

Click on the "Save" button when finished

You will use these same steps each fall to update your LSM (Lay Servant Ministry) data. Please feel free to share this information with other Lay Servant ministers (in the Catawba Valley District) who may not have email.

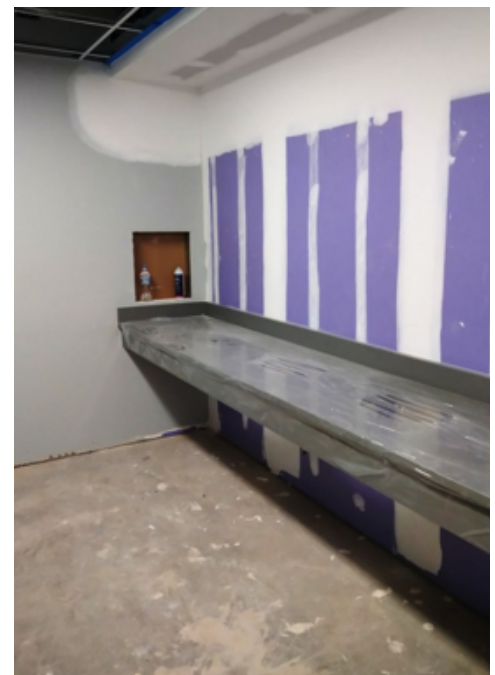


Electrical passed inspection, allowing the lights and HVAC system to be turned on (yay heat!!!). This photo shows a neat, tidy new electrical room...

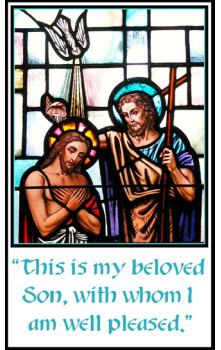

Deposits are due by February 28th (NON-REFUNDABLE)

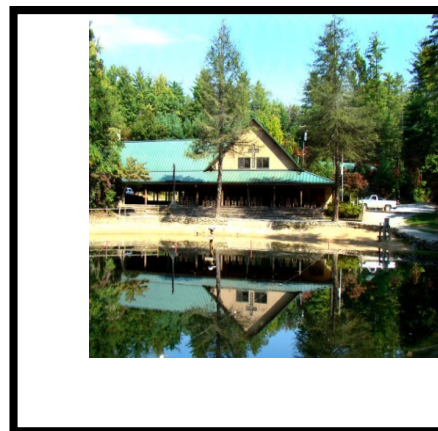
