
Resurrection Blessings KM Family and Community,

In collaboration with the Ingham County Health Department (ICHD), on March 16 Kingdom Ministries served the Lansing and Ingham County community as a Pop-up COVID-19 Vaccination Site. We were successful in facilitating vaccinations for 90 people. The second dose was administered April 13 at the KM Center for those who received their first dose on March 16. Please join us in thanking the many KM and ICHD volunteers who help to make this community empowerment effort a success.

Through prayer, by faith and with government guidance, and planning of our Safe Gathering Taskforce (SGT), we have successfully and safely resumed our in-person Sunday worship on March 7. Those who are comfortable with joining in-person have contributed to an atmosphere of praise and worship of our God. Others who are not as comfortable continue to contribute as they join via the Facebook livestream. Our in-person and livestream attendance is growing. Kudos to the Communication, Media and Arts (CMA) team for their diligent work in improving our livestream. Thank you for your patience as the SGT continues to make recommendations to adjust protocols in order to keep your health and safety a priority.
