In Matthew 6:10 and Revelation 21:3-5a, we see that God's will (His Rule) is good for us and for our benefit.

- Why do you think we so regularly reject God's will in our lives?
- How would your life look different if you truly believed God's way was best?
- What is one way that you can learn to trust God's will for you more this week?

In Romans 12:1-2 and Matthew 28:19-20, God tells us that His Kingdom is our mission.

- Does the Kingdom of God feel personal to you? Why or why not?
- What is one thing that God might be calling you to do in His Kingdom?
- Who could you invite to join with you in that mission?

In Hebrews 11:13&16, God honors those who live Kingdom-minded lives.

- Is Jesus the King of your life, or have you left the throne for other kings?

What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?

- Why did it get your attention? (What made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?
