Read Daniel 6:1-13

Each person share about one of the following questions:

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

In Daniel 6:14-18, Daniel's obedience to God throughout his life (he is likely in his 80's here) is an incredible testimony of what He believes.

- Is your life a testimony of someone who honors the Lord, or other things?
- Where have you seen the difference between "cultural Christianity" and someone who is really on fire for the Lord? Which one are you? Why?

In Daniel 6:19-23, Daniel's obedience leads to God using Him in a dramatic way.

- Is your character that of someone that God would use for great things? Why?
- How can you grow towards becoming the kind of person God can give ministry opportunities to?

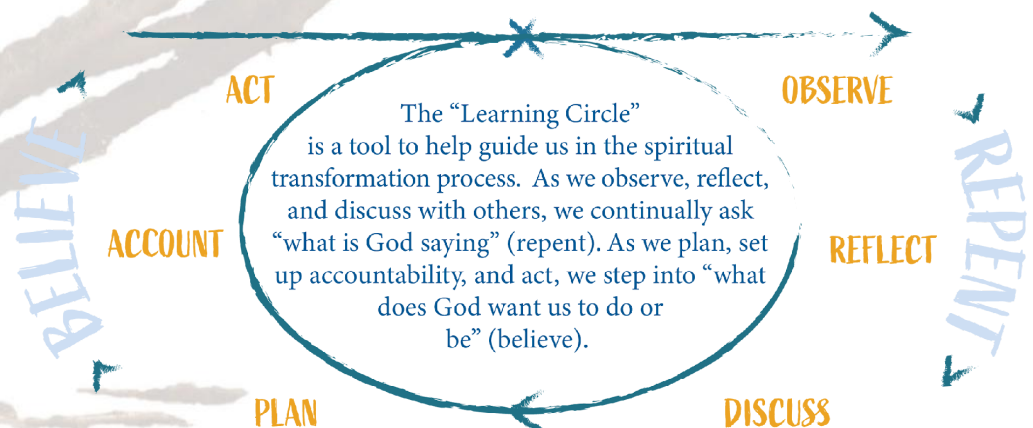
In Daniel 6:24-28, a national revival breaks out because of Daniel's faith.

- What kinds of things could God do around you if you obeyed Him fully?

What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?

- Why did it get your attention? (What made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?
