Read Joshua 1:1-9

Each person share about one of the following questions

- ☐ What did you like about this passage?

- ☐ What didn't you understand about this passage?
- ☐ What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

Read Joshua 6:2-5

- ☐ Discuss this "battle strategy". Why do you think God asked them to do this?
- ☐ What is the significance of the ark going before them?
- ☐ Discuss God's promise to be with Joshua and how this may have strengthened Joshua during the battle of Jericho.

Read Hebrews 11:30

- ☐ Discuss the statement "BY FAITH, the walls of Jericho fell."
- ☐ Discuss the role of faith in the walls collapsing.

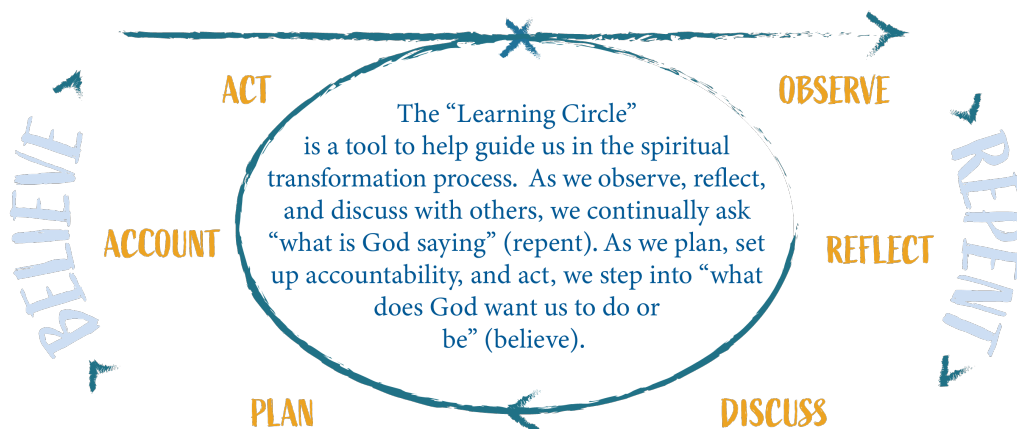
The walls of Jericho can be an analogy of those things that block us from God's promises. (also see Mark 11:23 for Mountains that also stand in our way)

- ☐ Discuss what walls (mountains) may be blocking you from God's blessings.
- ☐ How does the strength of your faith play into this?

- ☐ Why did it get your attention? (Did something make you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- ☐ What might God be saying to you about this?
- ☐ What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- ☐ What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?
